I want to thank Defending Freedom for your donation to "Sew Much Comfort". As always, I am overwhelmed by your generosity to our project. The 1,000 athletic shorts will be adapted and then distributed to wounded soldiers in order to allow them to recuperate in comfort with dignity.

I cannot express adequately how much the support of Defending Freedom has meant to our organization's mission. We rely heavily on donations of materials to continue to provide the soldiers with adaptive clothing. Lack of adequate funding to accomplish our mission is always a concern. We have an average of 25 new wounded soldiers returning to the States from Germany every week. Most weeks we are contacted by at least one additional hospital, either in the States or overseas, that want to begin obtaining adaptive clothing for their patients. We could not keep up with this demand if we had to rely solely on our financial contributions. Donations from organizations such as Defending Freedom are the reason we can continue to contribute to the recuperation of the troops!

I will distribute the shorts as soon as possible. I know that soldiers will be using these during PT sessions extensively! Thank you for helping us be able meet this critical need for the wounded troops! Your generosity and thoughtfulness are heartwarming and truly appreciated by the seamstresses and, most especially, by the wounded soldiers who will benefit.
